














- Whose perspectives are the poems being written from?

- P2: Fossil fuel industries










POEM BRAINSTORMING

POEM CREATION

EXAMPLE: SCHOOL UNIFORMS

- Students (P1): I want to wear what I want! Who cares if I sit in the front! I don't mean to be blunt, but my clothes are not an affront. They help me express myself.
- Principal (P2): I hear what you're saying, but when you wear those clothes it looks like you're playing. I'm just saying, uniforms are better, so put back on your sweater!
