The art of freestyling encompasses a range of skills that are useful to a student's academic and non-academic development.

Birthed in the streets of New York, and expanded in hip-hop's underground for decades, freestyling is a skill that challenges participants to think fast, think freely and to support other MCs.

ICEBREAKER



WORD/RHYME ASSOCIATION

- 1) Stand in a large circle around the class.
- 2) Choose your key word and write it on the board or on a piece of paper for everyone to see as you play. Next, choose which round they want to start with either word association or rhyme association.
- 3) Play a few rounds alternating between new words and word / rhyme associations.

Now that we've completed a few rounds of the game, let's close out our conversation with the following questions.

- What was difficult about this word/rhyme association game?
- What was exciting or surprising about this game?
- What is freestyling?
- How does this game relate to the art of freestyling?
- What skills and emotions are necessary to successfully win this game and also master freestyling?


