








SCENARIO 1

- * Balancing what feels good now with what's good later











YOUR INNER COMPASS



Ethical means doing what's right, even when it's hard or when no one is watching. It's about making choices that are fair, honest, and kind — not just what's easy or benefits you most.

You can think of ethics as your "inner compass" that helps you decide what kind of person you want to be.


At HELP VS. HONESTY

GAME DESIGN

Your Mission: Design a video game that shows responsible decision-making.

Include:

- Game genre, platform, and story hook
- One ethical or financial decision players must make











GAME DESIGN

EXAMPLE GAME: BUDGET BOSS

Players earn money through mini-games and must decide how to spend it—buying quick upgrades for fun or saving to build their own business.

Each choice affects their long-term success. How would you design your version to show the impact of smart or risky decisions?









GAME DESIGN

EXAMPLE GAME: CORPORATE COMMUNITY


A narrative adventure in which the player is a community leader.

You must decide whether to accept a sponsorship (money) from a controversial corporation. You can develop your idea quickly but risk public backlash or environmental damage.









GAME DESIGN
